ROVE UPDATE

We have completed and presented our transition plan to the BCITO on the transition process for the ATI to take over both on and off-job training for the Flooring industry. We now await the results. The BCITO are having a summit on 30th April to discuss this process so I will report on the updates in our next newsletter.

TRAINING RESOURCES

Our Resource Development Manager is currently working with the BCITO to develop resources for the new flooring qualifications. It is envisaged that FloorNZ will have access to these resources once the transition process has been completed.

We have also completed our first upskill training course which was well received and intend to offer more of this type of contextualized training over 2021 and 2022.
